

Winter Parking Regulations

From December 1 to March 31, overnight winter parking regulations are in effect between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.

ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING:

During the winter parking season, vehicles must follow alternate side parking from 12:00 AM to 6:00 AM, based on the calendar date:

ODD-NUMBERED DATES:

Park on the side of the street with odd-numbered property addresses.

EVEN-NUMBERED DATES:

Park on the side of the street with even-numbered property addresses.

EXAMPLE:

If it is 7:00 p.m. on December 20th and you plan to leave your car parked on the street overnight, you would need to park on the odd side of the street so that at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on December 21th, you are parked on the correct side of the street.

Any streets posted with “No Parking” restrictions shall remain in effect; therefore are not under alternate side parking regulations. Vehicles must be legally parked and in compliance with posted signs.

Vehicles parked in violation of these parking restrictions may be ticketed. We urge you to please take time to understand and abide by the City’s winter parking regulations to avoid the inconvenience and expense of parking tickets.





PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

Vehicles violating snow emergency parking rules will face:

- A \$50 parking ticket.
 - Towing of the vehicle to facilitate snow removal.
 - To retrieve a towed vehicle, the parking ticket must be paid at the Sheboygan Police Department prior to release.
